NYA's Summer Program 2025

Location: NYA's Summer Program will be hosted at **Eddy Elementary School**

Dates: June 23 – August 15

Field Trips: We're keeping our traditional four field trips this year!

Water Wizz: June 26 and July 24 (Weeks 1 & 5)

Scussett Beach: July 10 and August 7 (Weeks 3 & 7)

Students: Must be between 5 years old and 12 years old

Payment Policy Update:

- A \$50 registration fee (non-refundable) per family is due at the time of registration
- \$25 supply fee per child
- **Registration opens Monday, March 31st at 7 a.m.**

Registration Type	Hours	Price per day
A.M. only	8:30 a.m. - 12 p.m.	\$25
P.M. only	12 p.m. - 4 p.m.	\$32.50
A.M. & P.M. (Full day)	8:30 a.m. - 4 p.m.	\$50
P.M. Extended *Must register in addition to daily registration*	4 p.m. - 5 p.m.	\$10

- On even weeks, students can attend between one and five days
- On odd weeks, with field trips on Thursdays, students must be registered for at least 2 days. Students may **ONLY** attend full days on field trip days!
- Payment schedule:

- Payment due for the first two weeks registered: Monday, April 14th
- Payment due for the second three weeks registered: Monday, May 12th
- Payment due for the remaining three weeks registered: Monday, June 16th

Example: Sally has registered her child for weeks 3, 4, and 5 of NYA's Summer Program. At registration, Sally is responsible for \$50. On April 14, tuition for weeks 3 and 4 is due. On May 12, tuition for week 5 will be due.
